PROGRAM OUTLINE

The successful applicants will be under instruction 5 days a week for 10 weeks and will be involved in a variety of construction projects and are immersed in a fully operational construction environment.

The program is underpinned by technical training, employability skills and career education all integrated into a genuine workplace environment.

Students who complete the program will undertake the following:

- Certificate I in Construction
- Personal Development Program
- Structured Workplace Learning*
- Green Skills Training

*Structured Workplace Learning is designed to give the participant exposure to as many different career options as possible by observing workers in their environment.

DESIRABLE ATTRIBUTES

- Have passed English and Maths equivalent to a year 12 standard
- Have a driver's licence or be able to get one in the first 6 weeks of the program

ELIGIBILITY

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or a permanent resident
- Be a Queensland resident
- Are not enrolled in High School
- Have not completed a Certificate I in Construction previously
